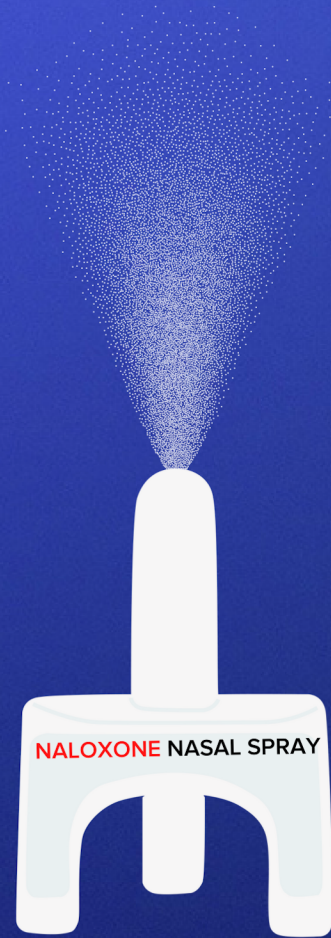

In Michigan, you can get naloxone through:

## HARM REDUCTION AGENCIES

## NALOXONE VENDING MACHINES

## MAIL ORDER

## PROVIDER PRESCRIPTIONS

- Ask your doctor to prescribe naloxone

## STATE REGISTERED PHARMACIES

- You do not need a prescription
- Pharmacist fills naloxone using the Michigan Naloxone Standing Order
- Pay the co-pay - the amount depends on your insurance
  - Medicaid: \$0 - \$3 co-pay
  - Other: up to \$149
